- 4. To enable reach and profile for the Lancaster Arts programme.
- 5. To enable alignment and added value with relevant strategies and initiatives beyond arts and culture, such as regeneration and health across the district, region and beyond.
- 6. To be responsible for the University's Collection Management Policy.
- 7. To provide oversight of the Lancaster Arts Board.
- 8. To report on progress to Senate.
